Items required include: One (1) Stretcher, Two (2) Blankets, Inspection Card and Accident Record Book.

A notice board displaying WSIB's poster known as Form 82 and the valid first aid certificates of the trained workers on duty is required. The employer shall ensure that the first aid station is at all times in the charge of a worker who is the holder of a valid First Aid Certificate and works in the immediate vicinity of the box.

Guidelines for Contents of First Aid Boxes

First aid boxes provide workers who have first aid training with the equipment they need to offer first aid service quickly and safely. The quantities of any item specified may be increased to suit the needs of a particular workplace. Personal protective equipment (for example, non-rebreathing masks and non-latex gloves) as prescribed by the first aid training should also be included in the first aid kits. In a location where a physician or registered nurse is available, the employer may authorize them to expand the contents of the first aid boxes. Equipment outside of the scope of first aiders, equipment that may deteriorate or that is potentially dangerous (for example, medication and ointments) should not be included in a first aid box. Section 6 of the Regulation requires that the boxes and their contents be checked regularly, minimum four times a year, to ensure that everything is in good order.
